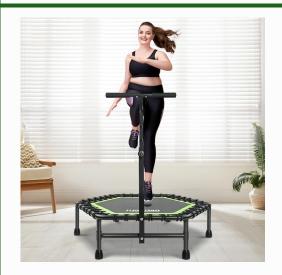

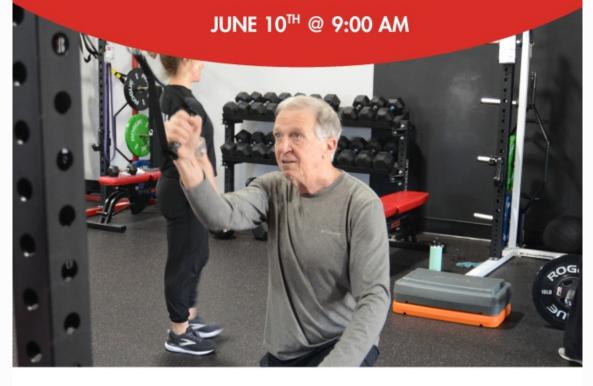

The Social Club meets once a month to discuss and plan excursions to local

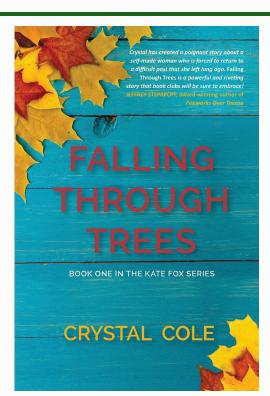

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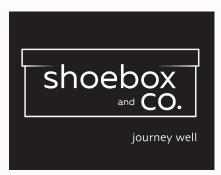

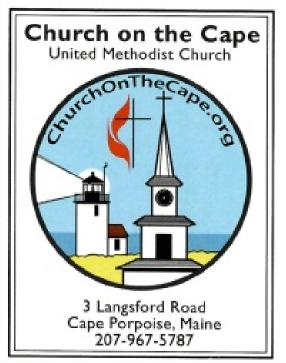
